

Another major outbreak of Mountain Pine Beetle is headed our way migrating south from Grand, Summit and Lake Counties. Last summer the Twin Lakes area of Lake County, just a few miles from Chaffee County, 'popped' with dying trees. The Forestry Committee urges our lot owners to spray their trees, we realize the cost of spraying is high. All your trees do not have to be sprayed, pick the 'best of the bunch'. If you need help in making that determination, give one of the Forestry Committee members a call and they will assist you. The Colorado State Forest Service has condemned 14 trees infested with MPB, this is excellent news for Game Trail's forest and is a result of so many of our lot owners spraying their trees.
