

Forestry Meeting 12-02-09 9am Sangre de Cristo

Beetle inspections are being completed at a great pace. Reports detailing hours spent, location of suspected trees (GPS is nice) are coming in. A few "hits" have been found, but the trees discovered have only a few and may be a result of "revisiting". Once all filings are complete Fred will check the suspect trees and set up a time when CSFS (Kathy) can come out for a look. There was a bit more discussion on the proposed improvements, ie. planting at and around the mail center. Supplemental water and protection from critters were also discussed. First course of action is to deer wire the surviving trees. A few large rocks may also be moved in. Early Spring work on trimming mistletoe from common area across the road will begin in March. A reminder will be sent out to residents to mark their property lines a little better by time next beetle inspections are done. The request will be for a minimum of a 3-4 ft. stake secured at corners with filing and lot #'s marked on the stake. Chip will remove some dead trees at Yale Crest intersection with Eagle's Ridge.
