We offer tours and information at our facility for those who want to know where recyclables are going and what they are being recycled into.

Following is a comprehensive list of what is recyclable and how to sort the different types of recyclables. Please do not bundle items in plastic bags in any containers other than the plastic container except for the use of plastic bags to contain shredded office paper as noted below. For information beyond this list please call Mickey at 719-207-1197.

Cardboard

- All corrugated containers
- Cereal boxes
- Six-pack boxes
- Egg cartons
- Pizza boxes without food in them
- Brown paper (including dog food bags and lunch sacks)
- Boxes need to be flattened
- Non-recyclable:
Waxy coated containers/ milk cartons, please place these in trash

Plastics

- Numbers 1-7 can be mixed together. Look for the number on the bottom of the container. No number means it is not recyclable. Patio furniture is not recyclable.
- **PLEASE** rinse containers as clean as possible as Angel of Shavano Recycling employees continue to sort plastics by hand and it can get disgusting
- Bundle plastic bags into one bag
- Please flatten containers when possible
- Petroleum and antifreeze containers must be rinsed three times according to EPA regulations.
- Styrofoam is NOT recyclable

Office Paper

The following are recyclable with office paper:

- All Envelopes

- All Computer Paper
- All Colored Paper
- Scratch Paper (Post-it notes)
- Mail
- Letterhead type paper
- File folders
- Manila folders
- Reamed folders (such as notebooks with a plastic or metal binding)
- All Magazines and Catalogs
- Phone Books (please remove magnets from covers)
- Construction Paper
- Shredded paper (please be bagged to keep from blowing away)
- Paper clips, staples, and all spiral bindings are also acceptable attached to paper.

The following are NOT recyclable with office paper

- Carbon Paper
- Cardboard
- Metal objects (with the exception of paper clips and staples)
- Garbage (to-go cups, wax paper, and tissue paper)
- Towels and Tissues
- Film and Photos
- Newspaper (separate container is available)

Glass

There are many different kinds of glass out there. Angel of Shavano Recycling *ONLY* recycles glass bottles. Other kinds of glass such as glass cups, glass glasses, glass windows and fixtures, and glass decorations are not recyclable.

- Clear glass needs to be separated
- Brown, Green, and Blue glass can be sorted together
- Porcelain lids which are very rare are NOT recyclable with glass
- Bottle caps and labels are acceptable

Newspaper

Newspaper comes in different grades and categories. Most packing papers are made with recycled newspaper and should be mixed with newspaper that is recycled. This packing paper looks like off-white or gray office paper. A good rule of thumb is anything that comes with your newspaper should all be recycled together. Please avoid plastic bags and other paper in this container section.

Aluminum and Tin

Angel of Shavano Recycling mixes aluminum and tin (labels on is acceptable) in the container at Game Trail due to the fact that our indoor facility allows us to separate the two on our time rather than your time. We ask that metal materials that are not in can or container form such as scrap metal and fencing not be placed into bins due to the fact that they take up too much space. For these materials, please call Angel of Shavano Recycling and we will work with you on each individual situation.
